

Imperial War Museum U Boat prints and Community Art Exhibition

Where: Old Bank Studios, Harwich.

When: Saturday 26th – 27th May 2019. Preview evening event 7-9pm, Friday 24th May.

Size of artworks maximum: No larger than 80cm wide, and 50cm high, or A2 framed. ALL PIECES MUST BE MOUNTED OR FRAMED WITH STRING READY TO HANG. Please speak to us if you have any queries.

Three categories for artwork and prizes:

Category	Proposed Prize
Ages 11 and under	Art supplies voucher & tbc
Ages 12 – 18	Arts supply voucher & tbc
Over 18	Old Bank workshop voucher and Arts supply voucher

Artwork will be judged by 3 local artists before the exhibition opening and announced during the preview evening.

People's vote to be decided over the Exhibition weekend. All winners will have the chance to be exhibited during the Harwich Festival in June 2019.

Brief:

An exhibition of original artworks and photography created in response to the 1918 German U Boat Surrender in the estuary between Harwich and Felixstowe, and the Official War Artist watercolours from the Imperial War Museum Collections.

2018 saw the centenary of the surrender on 20th November, when 100 years previous the first of almost 200 German U Boats and their crew were led into the Stour Estuary in between Harwich, Shotley and Felixstowe coasts. The event saw crowds of people and even the King visited to see the 'U Boat Avenue' that had been created off the coast in the early months of 1919.

We encourage a range of art mediums and styles. The Exhibition of the IWM prints and original artwork inspired by the surrender and the estuary landscape over the May Bank Holiday weekend to engage with the local community and this extraordinary heritage, with prize giving by a group of local judges for the three categories. People's vote also over the weekend.
